Resolution No. 3202

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and terminating on September 30, 2024 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 and

terminating on September 30, 2024 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

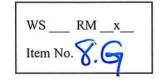

SYNOPSIS:

Approve Resolution No. 3202, to amend the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is proposed.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

The proposed budget amendment will amend the FY 2023/2024 budget by \$409,572.

BACKGROUND:

This amendment is proposed to recognize past grant years budgets that have not yet been spent along with a shortfall in administration expenses needing to be covered by a transfer from the General Fund.

The CDBG program is funded by a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), unspent grant funds remain with the City for a period until the funds are spent. This budget amendment will allow the CDBG program to access those past grant fund dollars of \$730,334. Furthermore, the City's CDBG budget is based on estimates of the current year's grant funds as those funds are not known at the time of budget preparation. This budget amendment will also true up the current grant dollars by reducing the current budget by \$411,425 and transferring \$30,221 from the General Fund to cover administration expenses as the current grant does not allocate enough funds to fully cover the administration costs of the grant program.

LEGAL REVIEW:

No legal review requested of the City Attorney.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is staff's recommendation that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 3202, amending the FY 2024 budget by \$409,572.
