#### Resolution No. 3050

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

## Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and terminating on September 30, 2022 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and

terminating on September 30, 2022 shall remain in full force and effect.

## Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

## Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

### Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

## Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

#### Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.



#### SYNOPSIS:

Approval of Resolution No. 3050, to amend the budget and the procurements for the resurfacing of roadways in the South Pinecrest Subdivision is requested.

#### FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

Funding in an amount of \$1,100,000 is requested and is available in the reserve Third Generation One Cent Sales Tax (3<sup>rd</sup> Gen) fund.

#### BACKGROUND:

Procurements totaling in an amount not to exceed \$1,100,000 is requested. \$450,000 to The Middlesex Paving LLC from piggyback (PBA 19/20-53) of Seminole County Contract bid number IFB-603616-19/BJC for Pavement Management Services. Seminole County's agreement executed on December 26, 2019. The procurements are as follows; \$575,000 to Asphalt Paving Systems Incorporated (APSI) of Zephyrhills, (PBA 21/22-207 Sumter County contract RFP 032-0-2021/RS Sumter County Pavement Maintenance and Rehabilitation Continuing Services) and \$75,000 to Caraway Concrete Construction of Oviedo, (IFB 21/22-29 City of Sanford continuing contract approved by Commission on 7/11/2022).

This phase of resurfacing will encompass a full depth recycling of the asphalt and base to allow a new asphalt surface to be applied. French Avenue from 27<sup>th</sup> Street south, Pinecrest Drive, Laurel Drive and Shannon Drive have been over-laid multiple times affecting the drainage and ride-ability of the roadway. The only way to correct the problem is to reconstruct the road base and surface.

#### **LEGAL REVIEW:**

The Assistant City Attorney has reviewed the documents and has no legal objection.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

City staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 3050, amending the budget and the procurements for the South Pinecrest subdivision roadway resurfacing in a total amount not to exceed; \$1,100,000; \$450,000 to The Middlesex Paving LLC, \$575,000 to Asphalt Paving Systems, Incorporated and \$75,000 to Caraway Concrete Construction.
