#### Resolution No. 3072

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and terminating on September 30, 2023 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

#### Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and terminating on September 30, 2023 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and

terminating on September 30, 2023 shall remain in full force and effect.

#### Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

#### Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

#### Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

#### Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

#### Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

#### Title of the Project: BolaWrap Restraint Device

#### 1. Description of the Issues:

City of Sanford Police Department seeks an available alternative which can restrain an individual, from a safe distance, who may pose a danger to themselves or others, is non-violently resisting an officer, or a subject with a mental illness which, if a hands-on approach was attempted, may excaberate the person's mental instability causing potential injury to all involved.

#### 2. Project Design and Implementation:

Currently, City of Sanford Police Department retains 36 BolaWrap restraint devices which are issued to approximately one-half of Patrol Division-also considered the first line of defense for city-wide calls for service. Increasing our BolaWrap restraint device inventory would allow all patrol officers the use of a safe and effective restraint tool without the need to use physical force or other less-lethal measures unless an incident dictates such necessity. BolaWrap devices are efficient restraint instruments when verbal de-escalation methods are ineffective yet less-lethal measures are not warranted. Use of the restraint device will decrease injury potential for both the officer and the subject encountered, as well as other bystanders. This can also reduce worker's compensations claims and possible city liability. BolaWrap allows an officer to restrain a subject who may be enduring a manic or mental episode, resisting an officer without violence, or threatening harm to themselves or others in the vincinity. City of Sanford Police Department has documented written policy and procedure which governs use of BolaWrap restraint device. Required instruction on function, use, and safety measures are provided to every officer before issuance of BolaWrap restraint device as provided by Wrap Technologiesgoverning entity of BolaWrap. Recently, City of Sanford officers effectively deployed two BolaWrap cassettes on a resistant, non-combative individual believed to be under the influence of illicit narcotics. The subject was taken into custody safely and without direct injury to himself, officers, or others.

#### **Project Identifiers:**

Equipment--General.

#### Capabilities and Competencies:

BolaWrap is a restraint device that deploys a 7.5 foot Kevlar rope which wraps around an individual's lower arm base or thigh-to-ankle base. The Kevlar rope employs 230 pounds of pressure around the body when deployed at a distance of 15-20 feet for full effectiveness. The City of Sanford Police Department is committed to continually providing a safe and welcoming environment for our citizens and visitors. Our goal is to use responsive measures to incidents only as the response to resistance dictates. BolaWrap restraint devices bridge the gap between an officer's verbal de-escalation tactics and less-lethal methods; thereby allowing use of a safer alternative with the least amount of force necessary. The physical distance Bolawrap restraints provide between an officer and subject also increases safety measures. It has been shown that BolaWrap cassette deployment on a person causes a "stunned" effect which allows officers to quickly move in and handcuff the subject before self-realization of what just transpired. Evidence-based research has proven the use of BolaWrap restraint devices has effectively deescalated several incidents which may have otherwise caused injury due to a physical "hands-on" approach or use of less-lethal and lethal measures.

#### 3. Plan for Collecting the Data for this Solicitation's Performance Measures:

**Primary Goal**: City of Sanford Police Department's primary goal is to equip all patrol officers with a Bolawrap restraint device.

**Objectives:** City of Sanford Police Department seeks to outift the Patrol division with Bolawrap restraint devices over the next two years. The objective is to reduce officer incidents involving physical response measures as well as decrease less-lethal, or lethal, response to resistance from non-combative and/or mentally compromised persons—while increasing overall safety.

**Deliverables:** Our empirical collection methodology will consist of measuring the number of hours in training and collecting Response to Resistance incidents when a Bolawrap restraint device was used. **Strategy:** City of Sanford Police Department strategizes to procure and provide equipment and any applicable instruction as required for device usage. Watch Commanders will collect the described empirical performance data and record it in their daily reports. Data obtained will be correlated and entered into City of Sanford Police Department's quarterly and annual reports. The Administrative Services Manager will submit the collected data within the quarterly grant performance reports.

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
