

Resolution No. 3071

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and terminating on September 30, 2023 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and terminating on September 30, 2023 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A". The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and

terminating on September 30, 2023 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.





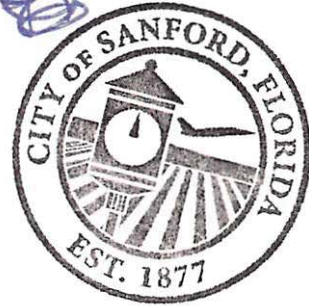

SYNOPSIS:

Approve Resolution No. 3071, to amend the budget and approve the 2022 Bullet Proof Vest Grant award received from the Bureau of Justice Assistance is requested.

FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

The Sanford Police Department was awarded the 2022 Bullet Proof Vest Grant in the amount of \$13,948. This is a match grant in the total amount of \$27,896.40.

BACKGROUND:

The Bureau of Justice Assistance is a component of the Office of Justice Programs within the United States Department of Justice and provides leadership and assistance to local criminal justice programs that improve and reinforce the nation's criminal justice system.

The Bullet Proof Vest Grant allows the agency to buy new or replace expired ballistic vests for officers at a matched rate saving the City of Sanford cost of purchasing them without the extra funding. The FY 2022 award may be used for National Institute of Justice (NIJ) compliant armored vests which were ordered after April 1, 2022.

LEGAL REVIEW:

The Assistant City Attorney has reviewed matter and has no legal objection to the receipt of funds under the grant.

RECOMMENDATION:

City staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. to amend the budget and to authorize the approval of the 2022 Bullet Proof Vest Grant in the total amount of \$27,896.40.
