

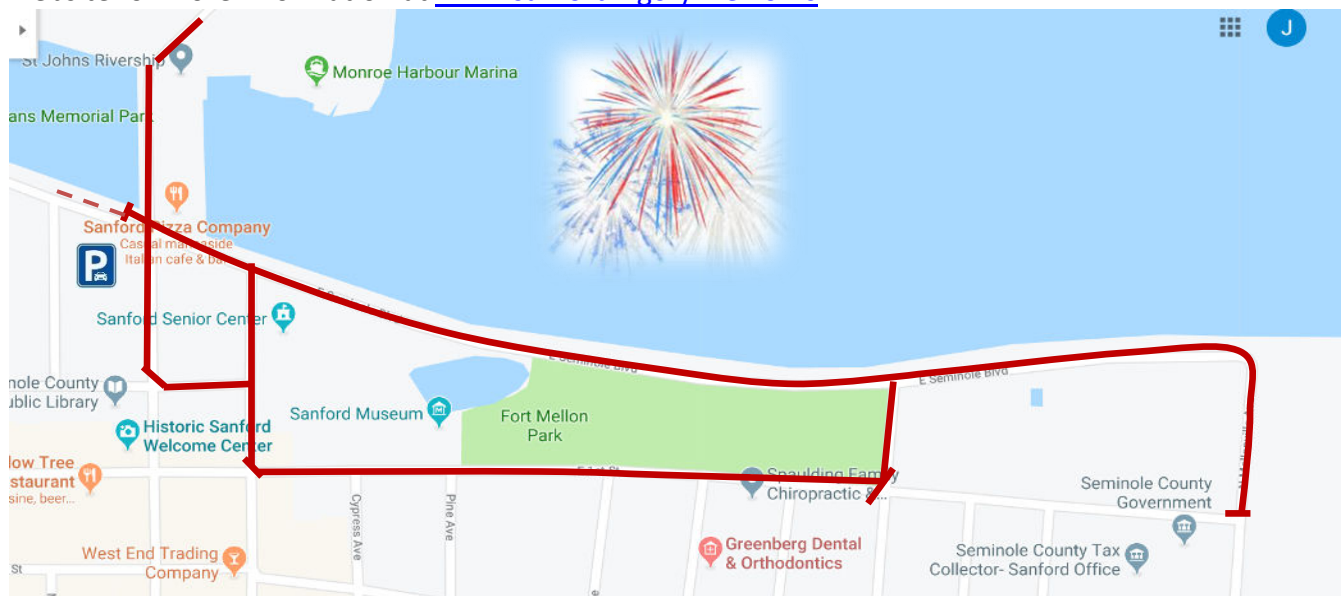
Notification of Road Closures

Star Spangled Sanford

Bring your friends and family to the City of Sanford on July 4th and start the Independence Day weekend with a BANG – a tremendous BANG thanks to Zambelli International’s choreographed fireworks show specifically tailored for our beautiful lakefront site with thousands of shells! STAR SPANGLED SANFORD on the Sanford Riverwalk begins at 7 PM with a Ladies327 Kids Zone, music, food and drink stations, as well as a variety of vendors on Seminole Boulevard, from Palmetto Avenue to San Juan Avenue. Although Ft. Mellon’s green space remains unavailable, the enormous playground, splash pad and pavilions will be open all day. Guests are encouraged to bring their blankets and lawn chairs to place in the viewing areas along Lake Monroe to enjoy the evening.

- From MIDNIGHT (0000 HRS) - 11 PM on July 4 closures include Seminole Boulevard, from Mellonville Avenue to Sanford Avenue; Mellonville Avenue and San Juan Avenue, from 1st Street to Seminole Boulevard; and 1st Street, from San Juan Avenue to Sanford Avenue. City Hall parking is also restricted for first responder personnel only.
- From 8 AM – 11 PM on July 4 additional closures include Palmetto Avenue; from Commercial Street to Seminole Boulevard; Commercial Street, from Sanford Avenue to Palmetto Avenue; and Seminole Boulevard, from Sanford Avenue to Hood Avenue (access to municipal parking lot at Hood is available). Marina parking lot is closed. Both Venue 520 on the Water and Marina Isle Waterfront Assisted Living close their parking lots with invitation-only access. Public Boat Ramps close at 8 AM and will reopen at ~ 11 PM.
