#### Resolution No. 2025-3344

A Resolution of the City of Sanford, Florida, amending the City's annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024 and ending September 30, 2025 relating to the Mellonville Drainage Project and a change order increasing Purchase Order #39982 pertaining to Universal Contracting and Construction, Inc.; providing for implementing administrative actions; providing for a savings provision; providing for conflicts; providing for severability and providing for an effective date.

Whereas, the Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida has adopted an annual operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024 and terminating on September 30, 2025 specifying certain projected revenues and expenditures for the operations of Sanford municipal government; and

Whereas, the City's budget presumes that each department generally will, to the best of their ability, maintain its expenditures within its allocated budgeted level and exercise prudence in expending funds during the course of the City's fiscal year; and

Whereas, from time-to-time circumstances and events may require that the original City budget may need revision such as with regard to a change order increasing Purchase Order #39982 relating to the Mellonville Drainage Project and the services of

Universal Contracting and Construction, Inc.; and

Whereas, the City Commission, in its judgment and discretion, has the authority

to adjust the budget to more closely coincide with actual and expected events.

Now, therefore, be it adopted and resolved by the City Commission of the City of Sanford, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget Amendment; Change Order Increasing Purchase Order #39982; Mellonville Drainage Project.

The annual operating budget of the City of Sanford for the fiscal year beginning

October 1, 2024 and terminating on September 30, 2025 is hereby revised and amended by Attachment "A" with regard to a change order increasing Purchase Order #39982 relating to the Mellonville Drainage Project and the services of Universal Contracting and Construction, Inc. The Attachment is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein verbatim. Except as amended herein, the annual operating budget for the City of Sanford for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024 and terminating on September 30, 2025 shall remain in full force and effect.

# Section 2. Implementing administrative actions.

The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution by means of such administrative actions as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.

### Section 3. Savings.

The prior actions of the City of Sanford relating to the adoption of the City budget and related activities are hereby ratified and affirmed with regard to a change order increasing Purchase Order #39982 relating to the Mellonville Drainage Project and the services of Universal Contracting and Construction, Inc. and related procurement activities.

# Section 4. Conflicts.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

### Section 5. Severability.

If any section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional, said determination shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section, sentence, phrase, word, or portion of this Resolution not otherwise determined to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional.

# Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

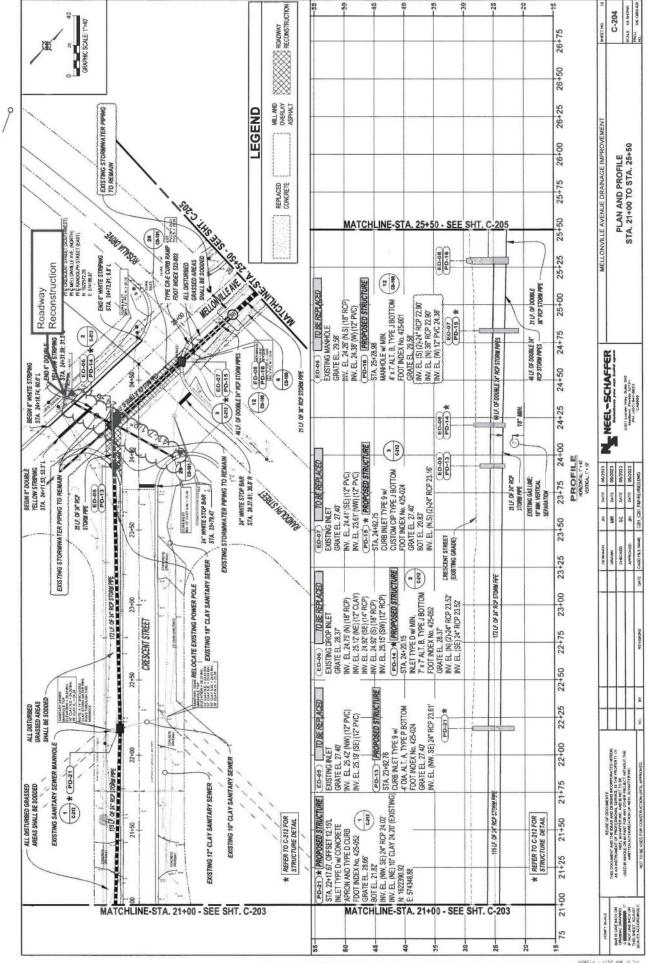

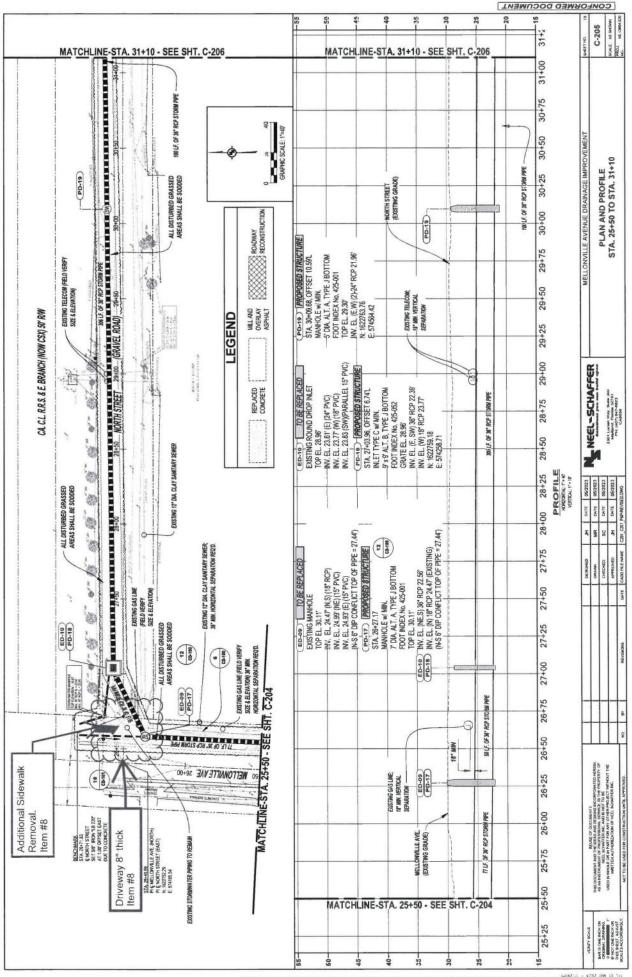

# SYNOPSIS:

Requesting to approve Resolution No. 2025-3344, implementing a budget amendment as well as the associated procurement activity/change order relating to Universal Contracting and Construction, Inc.

# FISCAL/STAFFING STATEMENT:

Funding is available from 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation Sales Tax Reserves to fund the change order increasing Purchase Order #39982 issued to Universal Contracting and Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$46,913.25 increasing the expenditure from \$1,937,155.90 to \$1,984,069.15.

# BACKGROUND:

The Mellonville Drainage Project is in process. There have been 12 work change directives which give rise to the need for the Change Order as follows:

- 1. Bonding Change in contract price increasing the bonding cost at 4.5% \$7,266.39.
- Mobile office and Port-P-Potty fees Change in contract time from change order 1 and 2 -\$1,521.54.
- Maintenance of traffic (MOT) Fees Change in contract and additional MOT for gas line relocation, also additional MOT for delay in environmental outcomes report responses and readwrite memories (RWM) and plan revisions - \$6,000.
- Surveying Fees environmental outcomes report requested survey of RWM/computer-aided design. and confirmation of elevations. of project along Washington Ave, PD-21 new layout, PD-01 new - \$11,520

- 5. Milling existing asphalt pavement, 2" average depth \$1,125.
- 6. Superpave asphaltic concrete (2" minimum) (SP 9.5) \$3,102.
- 7. Concrete sidewalk and driveway, 6" thick \$4,180.
- 8. Concrete curb and gutter, type F \$2,340.
- 9. Performance Turf, Sod \$950.
- 10. Removal of existing concrete (including curb and gutter) \$560.
- 11. Optional Base, Base group 06 (8" minimum) \$6,089.32.
- 12. Type B Stabilization (12" minimum) \$2,256.

An additional 14 days of performance time was added to the contract time due to the work change directives.

### LEGAL REVIEW:

The Assistant City Attorney has reviewed this matter and has no legal objection to the procurement activity, as proposed.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

City staff recommends that the City Commission approve Resolution No. 2025-3344, implementing a budget amendment as well as the associated procurement activity/change order.
